First published in *B.K.I.; Ex Bibl. Koninklijke Paketvaart Maatschappij*. - In 1830 the state finances of the Netherlands were in crisis following the Belgian secession and the Java War. To save the budget, Governor-General Johannes van den Bosch (1780-1844) introduced a system of agricultural deliveries: the cultivation system, in 1830. From that moment on, farmers in the Dutch East Indies, especially in Java, had to plant a fifth of their land with predetermined products. The products then went to the government. This culture system was very lucrative for the Netherlands. - *Scarce. Not in Cat. KITLV.*

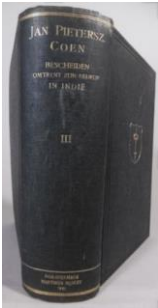

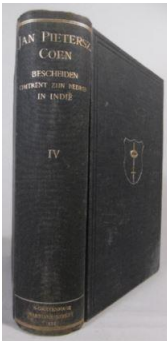

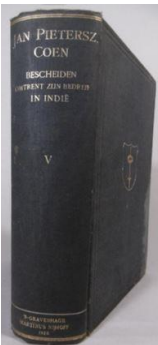

In the aftermath of the abolition of the Atlantic slave trade, Daendels tried to redevelop the rather dilapidated Dutch possessions as an African plantation colony driven by legitimate trade.

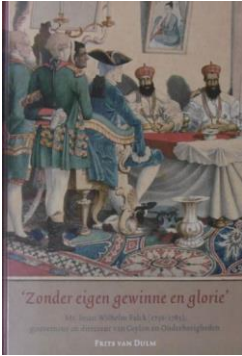

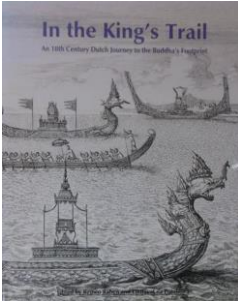

Ceylon, now Sri Lanka, has been an important part of the VOC network because of its production of cinnamon and other spices. The regulations drawn up under the Dutch authority at the time are part of Sri Lanka's heritage and are still in force in parts of business and contract law. The Ceylonees Plakkaatboek brings together the edicts, ordinances and other laws that the Dutch government issued in Ceylon between 1638 and 1796. The edicts are an important source for the history of the island in that period, including dealing with the agricultural and commercial policy of the Dutch government, the registration of real estate, public order and safety, family law matters such as inheritance and marriage and on religious politics. In this edition, the edicts are preceded by a detailed introduction to the history and organization of Ceylonese law in the relevant period.

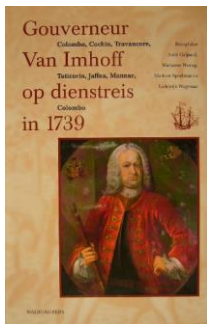
