First edition; with armorial bookplate of Isaac Meulman. - Benoit was born in 1782 in Antwerp and died in Brussels in 1854. During his stay in Surinam he had an eye for daily life in Surinam, he belonged to the opponents of the abolition of slavery: the Surinam slave-owners, from humanitarian motives and from natural self-interest, by no means treat their slaves as badly as is asserted by those who are in favour of abolition. He cannot avoid picturing the harsh and cruel daily existence of the slaves and explaining why they run away, revolt against their masters and are filled with



hatred towards the whites. When describing their dance-festivals, he says that the need to find an outlet for their misery accounts for the frenzy with which they throw themselves into it (*Introduction by S.W. de Groot to the facsimile edition*). He made a large number of charming and meticulous drawings. These very attractive set of views of Surinam include fine scenes of native life, showing costumes, dwellings, ceremonies, festivals,

recreations, interiors, utensils, etc. of the negro- and Indian population. Beyond the work's interest for its depictions of slave and native culture, the work includes several images relating to the Jewish population of the colony. Although there are many "written references to the Jewish vendors in the West Indies dating from at least the early 18th century, Jews ... were rarely visualized -- that is, they were not part of the standard repertoire of eighteenth century and early nineteenth century marketing and huckstering images set in the British West Indies. Certainly there is no image of urban Kingston quite like Pierre Benoit's lithograph ... of a Jewish shop that opens onto the main street in Paramaribo, Suriname [plate XVI]" (Kriz). The work also includes an image of "La Savane de Juifs" (Plate XXI). - Beautiful lithographed plates-book on the people and life in Surinam. - Except some marginal foxing as usual, a fine large-paper copy.

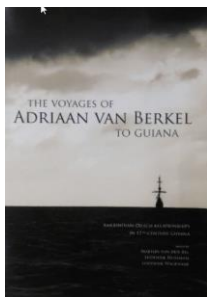

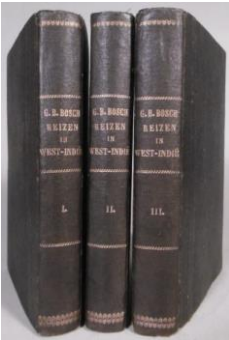
Arnold Borret (1848-1888) vertrok in mei 1878 naar Suriname. Hij was 29 jaar, jurist en had een aanstelling als griffier van het Hof van Justitie in Paramaribo op zak. Al



spoedig werd hij rechter en later ook lid van de Koloniale Staten. In 1882 gaf hij al zijn hoge functies op om toe te treden tot de orde der redemptoristen. Ook hier klom hij snel op in de hiërarchie. Hij werd priester en later provicaris. In 1888 maakte de tyfus een einde aan zijn leven. Borret was een gedreven tekenaar en schilder. Hij legde zijn indrukken van Suriname vast in een album met 66 tekeningen. Begin 1882 stuurde hij dit album naar zijn broer Theodoor in Nederland.

Deze schonk het in 1911 aan het Koninklijk Instituut voor Taal-, Land- en Volkenkunde. Voor het eerst zijn alle tekeningen uit het album gereproduceerd (*Inleiding*).

Various groups were brought to justice in Suriname and on St. Thomas. 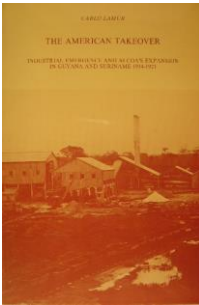
The first official account of the circumnavigation was published in 1626. - Jacques Le Hermite (1582-1624) commanded a punitive fleet of eleven ships and 1637 men to the coasts of South America with the objective of clearing the westward route to the Pacific of Spanish and Portuguese shipping. The fleet was outfitted under the auspices of the Dutch government, the two major companies, the Dutch East India Company and the Dutch West India Company, having little interest in the Pacific route. With the flagship *Amsterdam* along with the *Delft* under vice-admiral Geen Huyghen Schapenham and with Adolph Decker, captain of marines, Le Hermite's fleet left Texel on 29-4-1623, raided the coast of Guinea, then sailed south of to the coast of Patagonia. It then passed through the Strait of Le Maire and sighted Cape Horn on 14-2-1624. While in the region the expedition discovered and anchored in the Bay of Nassau, charting the surrounding islands (including the Hermite group). In addition, it was shown for the first time that it was possible to sail northward through the Le Maire strait. After coasting South America and plundering a few Spanish settlements, the fleet continued across the Pacific and was eventually disbanded at Batavia. Le Hermite, already a sick man at the time of the outward voyage, died at Callao in Peru and was buried on San Lorenzo Island near Lima. Command passed to Schapenham, whose article contains details of the latter section of the voyage (*Howgego p.615*). This account is combined with a description of Peru by Pedro de Madriga, an account of an English expedition to Guyana in 1596 (Kort-journael, gedaen naer het gout-rijk coninckrijck Guiana) and a discourse on VOC trade, none of which appeared in previous printings. - *A very nice copy with the bookplate of The Cruising Association.
