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

Emily Anderson (1891-1962), Irish editor and translator. She was educated privately and at the universities of Berlin and Marburg, and in 1923, after a short period as lecturer in German at University College, Galway, entered the Foreign Office where she served until 1951, having been seconded to the War Office from 1940 to 1943 for intelligence work in the Middle East. She dedicated most of the scanty leisure of her working life and all

her retirement to the successive tasks of editing and translating the letters of Mozart and his family and the letters of Beethoven. Her tireless, worldwide search for original sources of the text was complemented by scrupulous accuracy and thorough annotation. She developed a style of timeless English which she handled in as lively and readable a manner as was consistent with fidelity to the German. Despite an occasional lapse in musicological detail, the two editions were a fine achievement and likely to remain the standard English version for some time to come. Of the two, the Beethoven was perhaps the more remarkable because his illegible handwriting had produced so many inaccurate readings in earlier texts that Anderson, besides mastering his orthography, had either to inspect personally all the extant autographs or else procure photographs. Of the 1750 Beethoven letters, she published 250 for the first time. In her will, she bequeathed to the Royal Philharmonic Society money to found an international prize for violin playing. 

Frederic Lamond (1868-1948), Scottish pianist and composer. He was taught the rudiments of music by his brother, David. His reputation as a child prodigy spread, and in 1882 he entered the Raff Conservatory at Frankfurt, where his teachers included Max Schwarz (piano), Hugo Heermann (violin) and Anton Urspruch (composition). From 1884 he also studied with Bülow, honorary president of the Raff Conservatory, who was one of the most important influences on his musical temperament. He attended Liszt's masterclasses in Weimar and Rome between August 1885 and January 1886; having made his Berlin débüt on 17 November 1885 he soon appeared in Vienna and Glasgow. His reputation in Germany led him to settle there, although he travelled widely with tours to Russia, the USA (1902 and five further trips from 1922) and South America (1935). His opposition to the Nazi regime caused him to spend an increasing amount of time in Switzerland, and at the outbreak of World War II he moved back to Britain. Although he had success playing Brahms, Liszt and Saint-Saëns, he was most renowned as an interpreter of Beethoven.



Yesipova, Anna Nikolayevna (1851-1914). Russian pianist and teacher. Daughter of a high official, she studied at the St Petersburg Conservatory with Leschetizky, to whom she was married from 1880 until 1892. From 1871 to 1892 she lived mainly in western Europe, undertaking several very successful concert tours. She made her London début in 1874; her lightness of touch and singing tone were highly praised, but some critics took exception to her often exaggerated interpretations of Classical pieces. In 1875 she appeared in Paris and in the following year went to the USA. In 1885 she was appointed pianist to the Russian court. She taught the piano at the St Petersburg Conservatory, where her pupils included Prokofiev and Borovsky.



„The post office delivered a beautiful, sad Hungarian songbook to our editorial office. The cover reads: Songs, written by Antal Strache. He passed away at the age of twenty-two. The book was compiled by his father from his son's posthumous compositions. 


