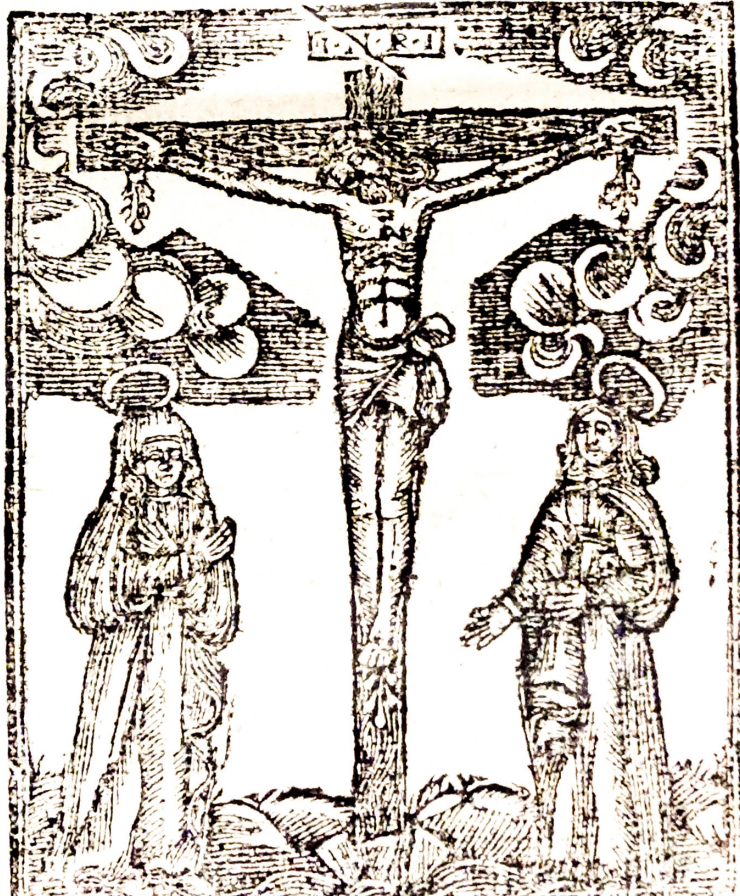

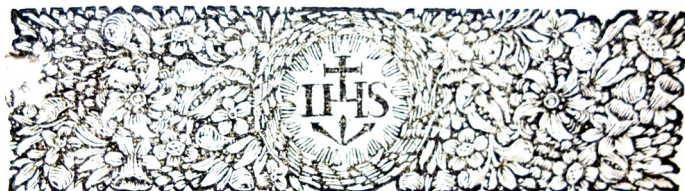

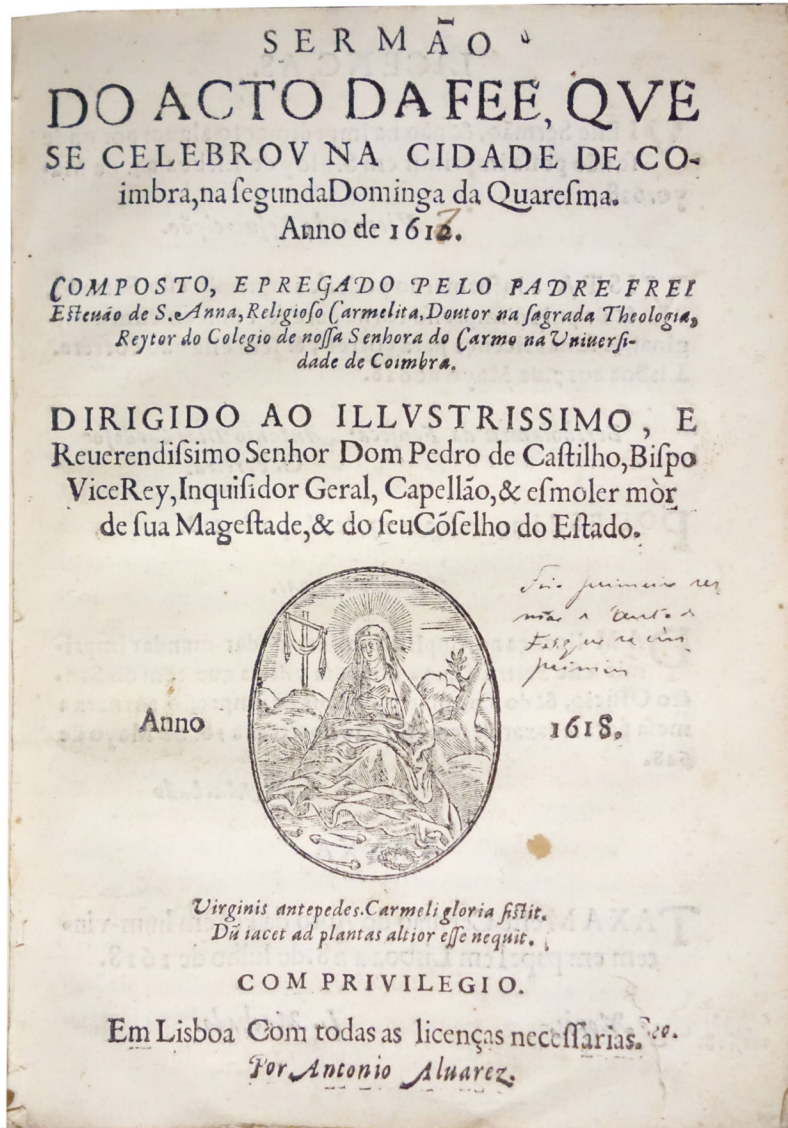

Second edition of the FIRST AUTO-DA-FÉ SERMON PRINTED IN PORTUGAL. The author (1558-1630), a native of Campo-maior in the Alentejo, was a Carmelite brother and one of the most noted preachers of his time. The first edition appeared in 1612.

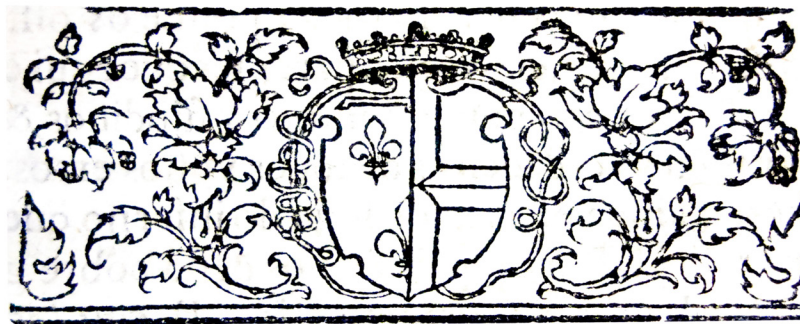

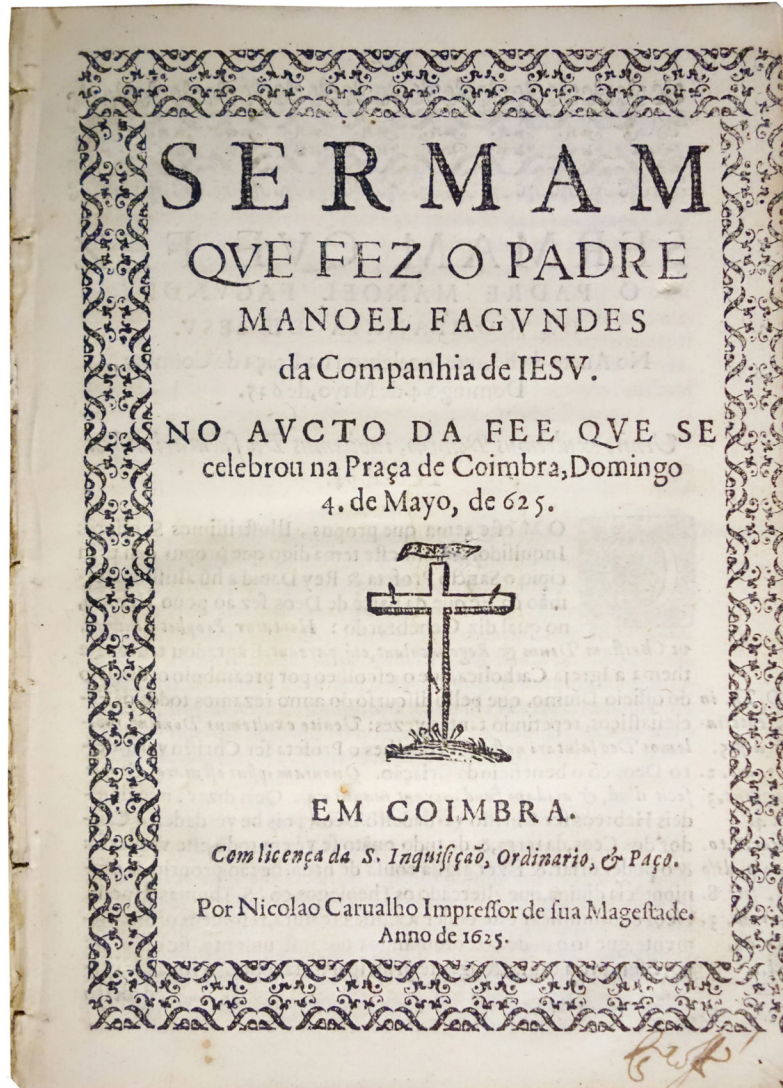

FIRST and ONLY EDITION of this Auto da Fe sermon based on *Psalms*, XCIV.

The author was a native of Viana do Castelo. He professed in the Jesuit order in 1583. Rector of several Jesuit colleges, he died at Coimbra, 1639.

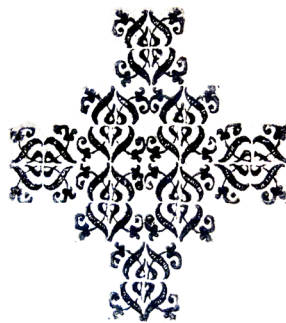

FIRST and ONLY EDITION of this Auto da Fé sermon based on *Deuteronomy*, XXXI, 27. There appears to be a variant issue with "pella" instead of "nesta" in the title.

The author, a native of Coimbra, entered the Dominican order in 1595. Prior of the Convento de São Domingos in Lisbon, Qualificador of the Inquisition, Barbosa Machado called him a "famoso Orador Evangelico". He died in Lisbon, 1663, said to have been over 84 years of age.

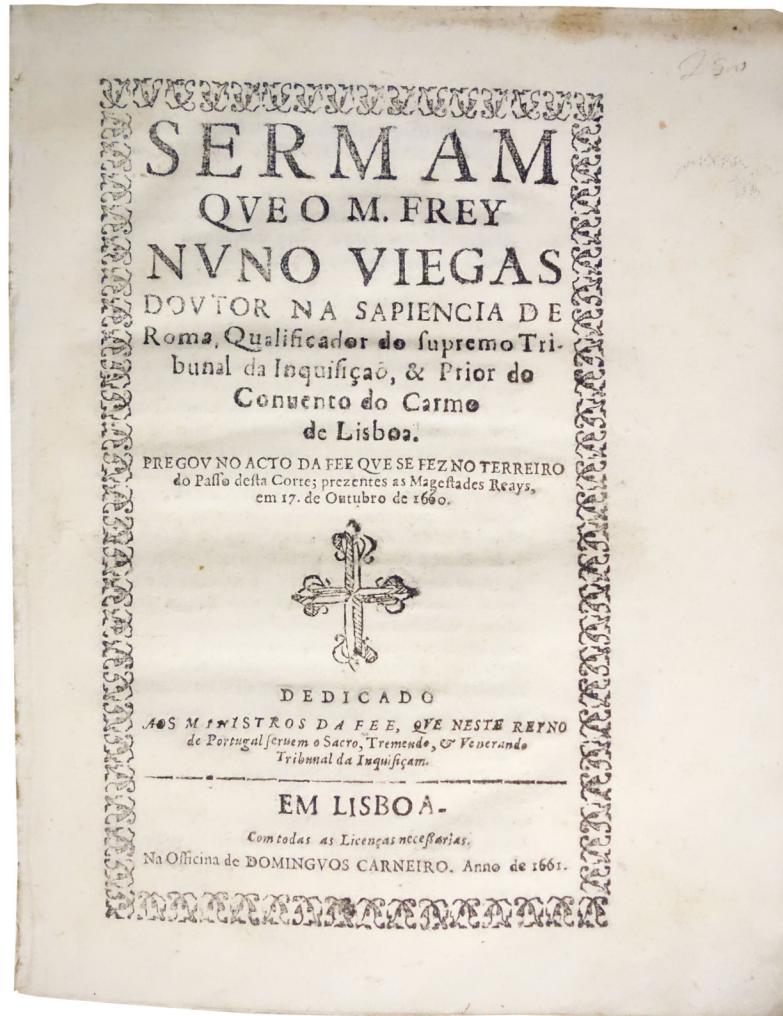

FIRST and ONLY EDITION (second state?) of this Auto da Fé serman based on *Hosea, I, 9*.

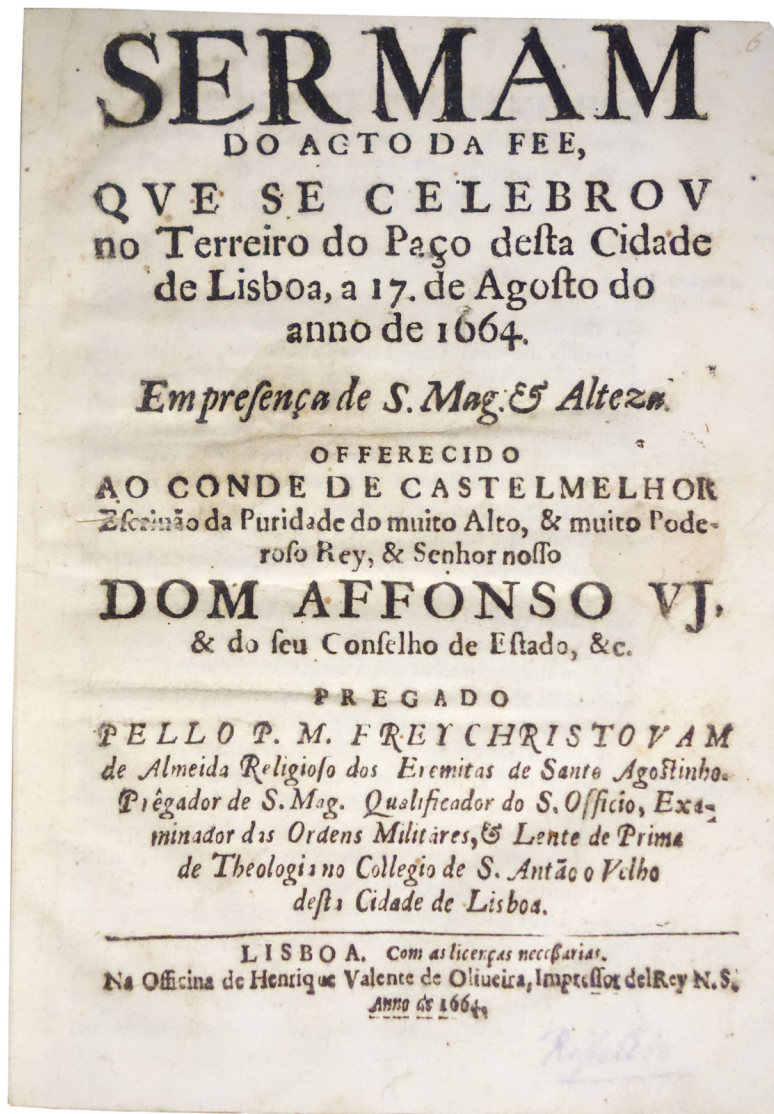
The Jesuit Father Bento de Siqueira [or Sequeira, (Arronches, 1588-1664)] was rector of Jesuit colleges at Porto, Dunchal, Lisboa and Coimbra, and Provincial of his order for the Alentejo. He spent a short time in Rome, and was considered one of the best orators of his time.

*Provenance:* The library of Victor Marat d'Avila Perez was one of the most important ever sold at auction in Portugal. A total of 8,962 lots went under the hammer from October 1939 through April 1940 from a six-volume catalogue, each volume lasting an unspecified number of nights (our guess is five nights for each part).

Frey Nuno Viegas, a Calced Carmelite, native of Évora, was Prior of the Convento do Carmo in Lisbon, and elected Provincial of his order in 1661. He died in 1666.

FIRST EDITION. It includes numerous references to Hebrew sources. This sermon appeared again in the author's *Sermoens varios*, 1673-86. Frei Christovão de Almeida (1620-1679), an Augustinian Hermit, was born in Golega (Estremadura). He earned a doctorate in theology and was Vicar General of the Archbishopric of Lisbon, auxiliary Bishop of Lisbon (1671), and titular Bishop of Martiria (1672). He preached in the Royal Chapel.

Padre Mestre Fr. Francisco Vieyra, an Augustinian Hermit born at Vila Real, Trás-os-Montes, held a doctorate from Coimbra University in Theology. He died in 1720, in his native Vila Real, age 71.
