

In the middle of the 19th century Sweden was affected by years of bad crop and famine. Since Sweden was still a very much agricultural society, this lead to massive emigration, primarily to North America. This newsletter deals with works regarding among other things, presentations of America, such as travel guides, advertisements for ocean-liners, buffalo hunting, American Indians but also some older works on the new continent.

Some six years ago, we were able to buy a book collection from the Östanå mansion, some sixty kilometers north-east of Stockholm. The original owners were keen book collectors and the library consisted of a large number of exquisite green halv morocco volumes. Most of these are already dispersed, but on the attic there were a number of volumes which had not yet found their way to the bookbinder. They are sewn and uncut in original wrappers. The contents are primarily contemporary facts and fiction, mostly Swedish but also some international works. We have just launched a *Cyber catalogue* of these charming books to our domestic clients and the link you will find below.

Hopefully you will find something interesting in either of these lists!



With relations of natural historic and other information, together with further information and pieces of advice for those who want to move there". Larson Swedish commentators on America 100. See Sabin A dictionary of books relating to America 6235 for a Norwegian translation printed in Oslo the same year. This book was very much read among Swedish immigrants. Contains of extracts from other author's works, like Holm, Klinckowström, Arfwedson, Gosselman, Schéele, Cassel and Helleberg.



7. COLERIDGE, HENRY NELSON. *Sex månader i Westindien, år 1825*. Öfversättning från engelskan med anmärkningar af C. A. Carlsson. Linköping, A. Petre, 1835. 8:o. (8),214,(1) pp. Somewhat worn contemporary cloth with some blind-tooled decorations. Spine slightly faded and with a minor stain. Slight foxing. Last leaf with some loss of paper in the outer margin. Gilt initials, "I. P." in the lower part of the spine. *4000

Six months in the West Indies translated from the third edition 1832. Translated by C. A. Carlsson who was the parish priest of the Swedish congregation at St. Barthélemy in the West Indies. He has added the translation with foot-notes which provide interesting insights into everyday life in the Swedish colony, as well as into Carlsson's racist beliefs about the slaves' situation.


population. Furthermore accounts of terms and conditions of acquiring land and also letters of recommendation from earlier settlers. The last page with an advertisement for the "steamship company Thingvalla", allegedly the only shipping company that offered a direct connection between Norway and America.

Hebbe Den svenska lantbrukslitteraturen 1017. "Short description on tobacco plantation in America" written by the former vicar of the Swedish congregation in Delaware. Dated Stockholm April 16 1731.

First Swedish translation of *Letters from the brave Mustapha Rub a Dub Keli Khan to his friends in Tripoli, during his imprisonment in New York*. A second




Swedish edition was published 1872. Translated by the Swedish poet Erik Sjöberg, a.k.a. "Vitalis".

The original *Traits of Indian Character* first appeared in *The Sketchbook of Geoffrey Crayon* in 1819. First Swedish edition. Translated by the Swedish poet Erik Sjöberg, a.k.a. "Vitalis".

12. KALM, PEHR [preses] & WESTMAN, GEORG A. [respondent]. **Itinera priscorum Scandianorum in Americam**, disseratione graduali. A.a. Åbo, J. Merckell, (1757). 4:o. Contains, among other things, *Helsing till fregatten Vanadis från S:t Barthélémy*, i.e. "A greeting to Vanadis, the frigate, from S:t Barthélémy" on pp. 10-15, which is a translation of a poem by "a young French lady living there". The French original is printed parallelly with the Swedish translation. The author recalls his memories from a trip around the world on Vanadis in 1867-68 on pp. 63-139.



Lidén Catalogus disputationum 315. Soulsby A catalogue of the works of Linnæus 2087. Academic thesis on the flora of Jamaica based on information from i.e. Patrick Browne's *The civil and natural history of Jamaica* 1756 and Hans Sloane's *A voyage to the islands Madera [...] and Jamaica* 1707-25.

15. (LYON, DAVID) **Några wälmenta råd och upplysningar för svenska utwandrare till amerikanska staterna.** (Tredje, tillökta upplagan). En reskarta medföljer. Falun, F. L. "A few well-meant pieces of advice and information to Swedish immigrants to the American states. (Third extended edition)". There is one undated edition and one dated 1868. The author was an agent for "The Montreal Ocean Ship Company and the Grand Trunk Railway". This little brochure informs the traveller among other things of trades in demand, the cost of various items and how to become an American citizen.

16. MEARES, JOHAN. **Tväinne resor från Ostindien till Americas nordvästra kust, åren 1786, 1788 och 1789.** Sammandrag utur engelska originalet. Stockholm, J. S. Ekmansson, 1797. 8:o. Occasional minor stains. Titlepage with some inksmudge over an old signature plus a signature. P. R. Sandwells book-plate. *4500



Sabin A dictionary of books relating to America 47265. Translated and with a foreword by Samuel Ödmann from the original *Voyages made in the years 1788 and 1789, from China to the north west coast of America*. Meares' work is one of the most important early books concerning the west coast of America in general and Alaska in particular.

See Sabin 59241 for the first French editions. A summary of *Recherches philosophiques sur les américains, ou mémoires intéressants pour servir à l'histoire de l'espèce humaine*. The first issue of the original was published in 1767, the second in 1769. The third issue was worked out as a defence of the two first. The author tried to find weaknesses in the American original population, something that aroused a lot of criticism. This work contains among other things, a lot of strange accounts about hermaphrodites, circumcisions and excisions. Published a number of times and also translated into English, German and Dutch.



Åhlén Censur och tryckfrihet 17.287. Sabin A dictionary of books relating to America 68101 for the original published in London and Haag the same year. This work was forbidden and confiscated by the Swedish authorities. A Swedish translation appeared in 1816.


"Installation speech, containing notes on the West Indies", held in the Royal Swedish academy of science. Swartz had made botanical excursions to Jamaica, Cuba and Haiti, and other places. He published a "Flora Indiae occidentalis" in 1804.

21. TERNAUX-COMPANS, H. **Underrättelse om den fordna svenska kolonien i norra Amerika kallad Nya Sverige.** Översättning från franskan, med anmärkningar och tillägg af översättaren. Sabin A dictionary of books relating to America 94855. Setterwall Svensk historisk bibliografi 1745. Translation of *Notice sur la colonie de la Nouvelle Suède*, from 1843. The addendum of the anonymous translator makes up the second half of the book.

22. **Treatise on the hair.** Chemical hair invigorator to prevent baldness & gray hair, to restore the hair that has fallen off or become thin, and to cure effectually scurf or dandruff. Prepared only by Edw. Phalon 61 Broadway. N.Y. New York, G. H. Clark, 1854. 8:o. 11,(1) pp. Title page with a decorative framework and some illustrations in the text. Sewn as issued and slightly worn. Some minor stains, especially in the beginning and in the end. *2800

The last page has an advertisement for "Phalon's paphian lotion, or floral beautifier, infallible as a preservative of the skin and complexion, as a means of eradicating or cu-ring freckles, tan, pimples, chapped hands, lips, and face, blotches, sun burns, scalds, burns, etc., and all diseases appertaining to the skin." Phalon warns a number of



times in this pamphlet of the peril of wetting ones hair instead of using his hair invigorator in order to avoid baldness, gray hair, scurf and dandruff: "Let this be impressed upon young and old".

"Treaty of friendship and trade between his majesty the

king of Sweden and The United States in North America, concluded in Paris on the 3 April 1783, ratified in the palace of Stockholm on the 23 May 1783, and in the Congress of the United states in America on the 29 July the same year". Negotiated by Benjamin Franklin and Gustaf Philip Creutz. After France, Sweden was the first nation to recognize the sovereignty of the United States.
