'Het belang van 'Pompeii' ligt niet eens zozeer in de onopgesmukte wijze waarop het dagelijks leven wordt geschilderd (met veel aandacht voor de stank, de stront en de pis), maar vooral in de wijze waarop naar de oudheden wordt gekeken. Mede omdat Pompeii zo'n enorme rol heeft gespeeld in de herontdekking van de klassieken, zijn er zeer veel volledig ongefundeerde theorieën uit vooral archeologische hoek over de stad de wereld in geslingerd. Beard neemt ze bijna stuk voor stuk op de korrel, weegt ze, en verplettert ze onder een spervuur van argumenten en gezond verstand. Hoe opgewekt de toon van 'Pompeii' ook lijkt, de boodschap is pessimistisch waar het de mogelijkheid van kennis over de stad betreft. Bijna stap voor stap leidt Beard de lezer door de opgravingen, en onderweg rekent ze achteloos af met de bestaande visies op zaken als huisdecoratie, het aantal bordelen (volgens haar slechts één echt), godsdienst (volgens haar is het pertinent onjuist om het Forum te beschouwen als pronkstuk van de keizercultus) enzovoort.' (...) Blok biedt een zeer overtuigende, dieogravene analyse van het werk van een aantal van haar voorgangers. Conclusie van dit alles is een eigen plaatsbepaling. (...) In het tweede gedeelte van Bloks studie wordt ten eerste de wordingsgeschiedenis van het Amazonen-motief, ten tweede de ontwikkeling van de mythe in de tijd behandeld. (...) De grote aandacht voor het ongeschreven materiaal naast de tekstuele bronnen is zeker niet de minst aantrekkelijke kant van dit boek; ondanks de vele problemen die een beschouwing van de iconografie met zich meebrengt, heeft Blok terecht gemeend beide typen bronnen te moeten behandelen. Het verleent haar boek een grote meerwaarde. In haar analyse van het taalgebruik, van de verhaalstructuren en van de afbeeldingsschema's toont Blok ons de ambiguïteit van de figuur van de Amazone: er schuilt een fundamentele tegenstrijdigheid in een vrouw als strijder. Dit concept botst met het traditionele Griekse ideaal inzake de rolverdeling tussen de seksen.' Jacobs observes that 'Valckenaer alone has done more for Theocritus than all the previous editors of the poet put together; so that it may be said the poet owes more to the critic than the critic to the poet.' The edition of 1773, although correct and learned, contains only ten of the Idylls; the edition of 1779, the whole of Theocritus with Bion and Moschus. The notes are short, but critical and perspicuous; and the corrections of Brunck are oftener admitted than rejected. The basis of the edition was Winterton's (see Oxford editions of Theocritus, 1676-99), which is however, amended in a variety of places by the help of MSS. The annotations in 'Adoniazusas' are wonderfully learned, and contain a treasure of curious Grecian literature and antiquity. 'the edition of 1779', says Dalzel, 'is purely critical, and chiefly devoted to the restoration of the genuine readings of Theocritus.' The edition of 1781 and 1810 are a reprint of that of 1779.
