"...the American century of index numbers was to be ushered in by Professor Irving Fisher's monumental work *The Making of Index Numbers*, the fountainhead of almost all the best later work. ...Fisher analyzed, classified, and "rectified" existing and possible index number methods by means of certain previously established tests; that is to say, he formulated certain conditions which index numbers ought to satisfy; and ever since most of the theory of index numbers has really been the theory of these tests. This is much more important than is the search for an "ideal index number" per se, though of course the tests were devised in order to rationalize this search." (Schumpeter)

In this paper Professor Hayek considers the conditions under which it is possible for government to enlarge total expenditure by increasing the quantity of money. He argues that history indicates that, sooner or later, the control of the supply of money by government has ended in inflation. (from preface)

Four main methods are examined: 1. The Static (classical and neo-classical), 2. The Temporary Equilibrium method (of the authors's own Value and Capital), 3. The Fixprice (post-Keynesian) method, 4. The Growth Equilibrium method, developed in most recent years. (from dust jacket)

First edition. This is the third book that the author has written about capital; but there is hardly any overlap. *Capital and Growth* (1965) was a largely expository work, the present volume is more constructive. It takes up the approach that was peculiar to the Austrian School of 1890-1930; an approach which has largely been abandoned because of an obstacle which it failed to surmount. It is shown that the obstacle can be surmounted and the method restored to vigor. What results is a modernization, not only of the Austrians, but also of the English classics – Ricardo and Mill. The contributions to this book are devoted, directly or indirectly, to various aspects of a fundamental problem of normative economics: the best allocation of limited means towards desired ends. The central place of this problem in economic thought explains what otherwise might seem like a surprising fact: that the studies here assembled bring out affinities and connections between lines of thought and funds of experience developed in apparent independence by various groups of economists, mathematicians, and administrators. The volume thus testifies to the fundamental unity of the economic problem, even though the approaches and points of view may vary widely. (from introduction)

Ihr wichtigster Beitrag war die Lösung der offenen Fragen der Marx'schen Akkumulationstheorie. Sie verwarf das Say'sche Gesetz und versuchte zu beweisen, dass die Akkumulation weitgehend von den Wachstumsaussichten des Marktes bestimmt wird.
