Whitlam launches ANB

The Australian National Bibliography 1901-1950 (ANH) represents a milestone in Australian publishing and is one of the Library's two major contributions to our bicentenary. The other is the exhibition, People, Print & Paper.

The ANB 1901-1950 plugs what is often called "the Fergisson Gap"; the years between Sir John Ferguson's Bibliography of Australia (1784-1900) and 1950 when the National Library began producing its Annual Caralogue of Australian Publications and was superseded a decade later by the dum/altan National Bibliography.

Mr Whitiam said: "This (ANB 1901-1950) will be an enduring tribute to what's been built up over many de-
