In 1636 he traveled to Dutch Brazil, where he stayed until 1644, invited by count John Maurice, Prince of Nassau-Siegen. There, he painted portraits of the natives, slaves and mulattos of Brazil in the seventeenth century, besides numerous sketches of plants and animals.

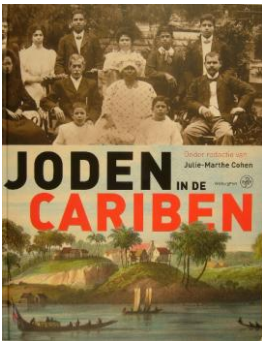

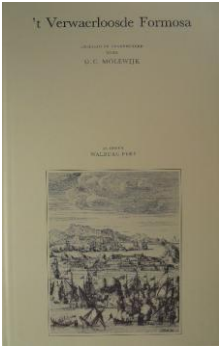

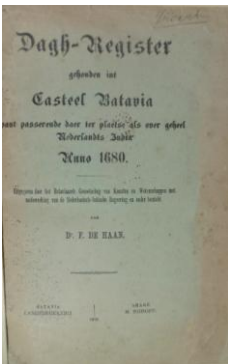

In the aftermath of the abolition of the Atlantic slave trade, Daendels tried to redevelop the rather dilapidated Dutch possessions as an African plantation colony driven by legitimate trade.

The most important letters from Asiatic rulers have been included in translation together with their replies. A source of primary importance for all events in Asia insofar as these were of interest to the VOC (*Coolhaas pp. 28-29*).

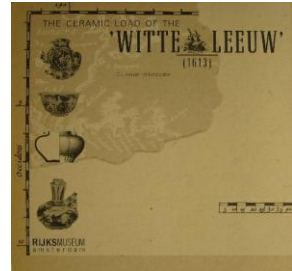
