

### **PERSPECTIVE VIEWS, VUE PERSPECTIVE, VUE D'OPTIQUE, GLÜCKKASTENBLÄTTERN**




These engraved views were meant to be seen with a special viewer to enhance the three dimensional effect, a zograscope. This is an optical device for enhancing the sense of depth perception from a flat picture. It consists of a large magnifying lens through which the picture is viewed. Some models have the lens mounted on a stand in front of an angled mirror. This allows someone to sit at a table and to look through the lens at the picture flat on the table. Pictures viewed in this way need to be left-right reversed; this is obvious in the case of writing. A print made for this purpose is called a vue d'optique or perspective view. They were very popular in the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> centuries. The colouring is often bright and naïve, as for children's illustrations. Travelling vendors who went around to fairs offering these views, often did the handcolouring themselves, so it tends to be a bit rough compared with other period engravings. In our view this adds to the charm of these views







Fine view by 'the Dutch artist Jan van Ryne (ca. 1712-1760), he was believed to have worked in London about 1752-54, when he made an interesting engraving of Table Mountain and Bay, first published by Robert Sayer of Fleet St., London, in 1754, and provided the basis from which other prints were made, one being engraved in reverse in Paris (*Gordon-Brown, Pictorial Africana*, p.234). We offer the French version of this very attractive view of the Cape of Good Hope from the sea showing the Table Mountain and the company's buildings and many ships in Table Bay. It was an obligatory stop for all European ships going to the Indian Ocean or returning from there to Europe. They stayed a long time to reprovision and to let their crews rest. - *A fine copy. Scheen II, p.277.*



## 9. COLOSSUS OF RHODES.

The Colossus of Rhodes was a statue of the Greek titan-god of the sun Helios, erected in the city of Rhodes, on the Greek island of the same name, by Chares of Lindos in 280 BC. One of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, it was constructed to celebrate Rhodes' victory over the ruler of Cyprus, Antigonus I Monophthalmus, whose son unsuccessfully besieged Rhodes in 305 BC. Before its destruction in the earthquake of 226 BC, the Colossus of Rhodes stood over 30 metres high, making it one of the tallest statues of the ancient world. - (Small part of lower blank margin repaired). - *Very attractive view.*





Göttingen University Library, founded in 1734, was the first library to be conceived and realised as a modern research library. It was the first academic universal library of European standards. - (Top margin trimmed, not affecting the image; lower margin cut short with loss of part of name of the publisher). - *Very attractive view.*

Fine bird's-eye view from offshore of the fort in Madras, now Chennai, with many ships in the foreground. 'Madras was the Company's first fortified settlement in India; the construction of Fort St George began in 1640 and continued on and off for another 150 years. It houses all the administrative and military necessities, as well as St Mary's church (the oldest Anglican church in India), finished in 1680. The Old College, the equivalent of the Writers' Building in Calcutta, was one of the Company's few eighteenth-century buildings in the gothic style, and still stands' (*Wild, The East India Company*, p.52). rare view of the first major English settlement in India and the foundation stone of Chennai - Some foxing otherwise fine.






