Beautiful, and as complete as here, very rare set of Illustrations to Goethe's poems, by the most important German artists of that time. One of 100 numbered copies, this copy numbered with a letter(!), of the deluxe edition. To each volume there is an extra-suite of illustrations on thin Japan-paper and under Passepartout, which contains also the illustrations which were not used, all signed by the artists. - Volume 1: Max Liebermann. With 15 lithographed illustrations in the text and a suite of 16 signed original lithographs (Achenbach 63-79). - 2: Ernst Barlach. With an handwritten index. Bound in contemporary cloth. - A unique copy.

Käthe Berl was a student at his class for Jugendkunst at the Kunstgewerbeschule of the Austrian Museum of Culture and Industry in Vienna. The artists of the Wiener Werkstätte sought inspiration in naive children's art and folk art.

Important educational instrument on the field of child and juvenil art education. The illustrations are from pupils of the class of Franz Cizek between the years 1910 - 1924. They show strong influence from the Wiener Werkstätte and Viennese Art Nouveau. Rare. - Dust jacket with some minor defects.

Haute Couture in watercolours. Lovely ensemble of festive dresses for woman from old Greek and Roman times until early 20th century. With large size, detailed elaborated dresses in different colours. Haute Couture of France was made mainly at court, therefore Debouny arranges the water-colours not only epochs, for example 11-15 century. Revolution, Empire, Restauration, Republics, but also by the names of fashion-conscious sovereigns respective their mistresses, for example Francois I and Eleonore of Castilla, Henri II and Catarina de Medici, Francois II and Maria Stuart, Henri IV and Maria de Medici, Louis XIV, Maria Theresia resp. Madame de Maintenon, Louis XV and Maria Leszcynska, Louis XVI and Maria Antoinette, Louis Philippe and Maria Amalie, Napoleon III and Eugenie de Montijo. The manuscript was made between October 1913 and summer 1914. It is a rich source to reflect how fashion changed during the centuries and a must for everyone who studies especially the French Haute Couture.

Interesting inventory of the well-known Viennese Jewellery-designer Johann Baptist Hellmer. Lists accurate the stock of jewellery, gold and fancy-goods, silver-objects, precious coloured stones etc.all with quantity, carat and price. the total adds up to 8468,21 coronas. Johann Baptist Hellmer won a bronze-medal for his designs in an trade-exhibition in 1835.

On the opposite page a handwritten explanation of the image, mostly signed Henritte Polwarth and dated. Henritte Polwarth belonged to a famous British noble family. The plates, numbered from 1 to 20, mainly with British and Scottish images: The Island Wight, Ryde, Edinburgh, Pont of Water of Leith, View towards Cheviot Hills, a few plates on different views of the River Tweed, Eildon Hills, Villa d'Este a Tivoli, Abbey of St. Pons etc. All the plates are of very high artistical quality, very detailed and in perfect state of conservation. only one plate with a few stain. The edges of the royal binding a bit rubbed.





The most beautiful German book on insects of its time. The very fine elaborated engravings by Rösel have been "carefully coloured by Kleemann and his wife K.B. Rösel von Rosenhof" (Landwehr, Studies of Dutch books, 161). The fourth volume was edited after his death by his son in law Christian Friedrich Carl Kleemann. This volume with a portrait of Rösel. - BOUND IN VOLUME II: (Schwarz, Christian). Nomenclator über die in den Röselschen Insekten-Belustigungen und Kleemannschen Beyträgen zur Insekten-Geschichte abgebildeten und beschriebenen Insekten und Würmer mit möglichst vollständiger Synonymie. Title, 62 pages. - The first three volumes uniformly bound; with wide margins and very clean; volume four in a different, contemporary binding, this partly rubbed, inside some browning and foxing. - Rare. - In 1792/93 there was published a book by C.F.C. Kleemann, Beiträge zur Natur- und Insecten-Belustigung, seen as a supplement to Rösl von Rosenhofs work, which is mostly missing. - The work as offered here is complete. - Nissen ZBI 3466. - Eines der schönsten Insektenwerke des 18. Jahrhunderts.





Heinrich Vogeler (1872 Bremen - 1942 Kasachstan) was one of the most famous German painter and graphic designer of the German 'Jugendstil' which made him very famous. He belongs to the first generation of the 'Künstlerkolonie Worpswede'. His house, the 'Barkenhof' became the center of the artistic movement at the beginning of the 20th century. - With his monogram in the plate. With blind-stamp 'Ludwig Möller, Lübeck'. Signed by the

printer 'O. Felsing'.
