







The earliest advises 6 "survival secrets for atomic attacks" before moving on to first aid for snakebite, electric shock, etc. while the two from the '60s focus on Cold War era needs; specifically, the "fallout shelter" that no home should be without. The gap in time is profound. All three items in very good clean condition.


