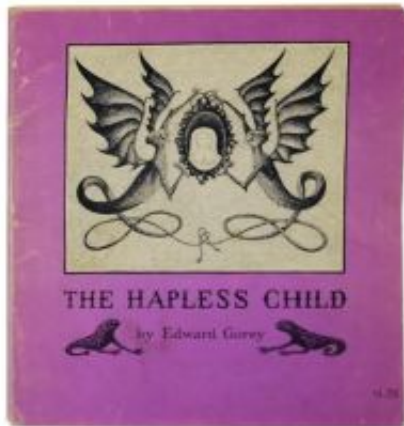


Happy Birthday Edward Gorey. We recently acquired a small collection of Edward Gorey books.
